***An Overall High Point and Reserve High Point** will be given in each Age Division at EACH Show. THIS MUST BE DESIGNATED WHEN YOU TURN IN YOUR TAB SHEET AT THE BEGINNING OF THE DAY.

***A Year-end Overall High Point Buckle** will be given in each Age Division and Reserve High Point award TBA will be given at the end of the year. Requirements are stated in the Rule Book and classes are noted on the Tab sheets.

***A High Point and Reserve High Point** will be given for English, Western and Speed at the year's end in each Age Division. Classes to qualify are designated on the Tab Sheet and in the Rule Book.

The Hunter Hack and Trail Classes will be set up in the warm up arena and held in the warm-up arena to speed the show.

Class Sponsorships will be due by August, a penalty to the member will be \$10 per month to those turning in their sponsors after this date. This will give the Sponsors the publicity that they deserve and have their name in print for at least five shows and newsletters.

The Newsletters will be emailed monthly to the members, a link to the web page will be sent for the member to open and view the newsletter. For those members without an email address the newsletters will be available at the next show.

General Membership meetings will be held during the lunch break at the May, August and November shows.
