SSRC Rulebook Reminders!

C. Spectators will not be allowed in the alleyways. Spectators should use common arena courtesy, and keep "safety first" in mind. Alley way into the arena must be clear at all times. There should be no spectators, trainers, or riders on horseback blocking any of the alleyways or entrance into the arena.

I. All classes must be sponsored in order to qualify rider/horse for any High Point or Years End Awards by August show or will be fined \$10.00 per month penalty after August until sponsor/donation is paid. C. NO SCHOOLING YOUR HORSE IN THE ARENA in a manner that would disrupt other contestants. If a horse becomes unruly, the rider should pull to the center of the arena or excuse himself/herself. This will be determined and enforced by the judge and/or the officers.
