## ATTENTION! IMPORTANT!!!

At the past several shows, we have had many complaints about entrants and spectators approaching our judges during the show. It is both a SSRC rule and an AQHA rule that this is NOT to be done. If you must speak to the judge you must follow the proper procedure to do so. **YOU MUST** go through the RING STEWARD or another SSRC Show official FIRST! SSRC is going to have to install a ZERO TOLERANCE rule about speaking to our judges. From the July show on, any member or spectator that approaches the judge about anything during the part of the show that the judge is judging (before SPEED EVENTS) without following the proper procedures -- will be asked to leave the show with NO REFUND. Please respect our judges, as well as your fellow entrants!

## From AQHA RULEBOOK:

- (h) After the judge has accepted a judging assignment, exhibitors shall not contact, nor attempt to contact the judge pertaining to judging of any horses at that show. Further, exhibitors shall not approach judges for any reason prior to the completion of judging unless the ring steward is present.
- (i) Any request to speak to the judge must be made through the ring steward.
- (j) No exhibitor will visit or socialize with a judge the day prior to or day of the show.
- (k) When an exhibitor makes a request through the ring steward or other show official for the judge's opinion concerning that exhibitor's horse, it is urged that the judge will give his/her opinion courteously and sincerely in the presence of the ring steward or other show official; however, there will be no

fraternization between an exhibitor and judge during the show.

(l) An AQHA-approved judge shall be treated with courtesy, cooperation and respect. No person, exhibitor, owner, or otherwise, shall direct abuse or threatening conduct toward them, either in the furtherance of their judging duties, or as a result thereof, whether or not the conduct occurs during an approved event or show, or on show grounds.

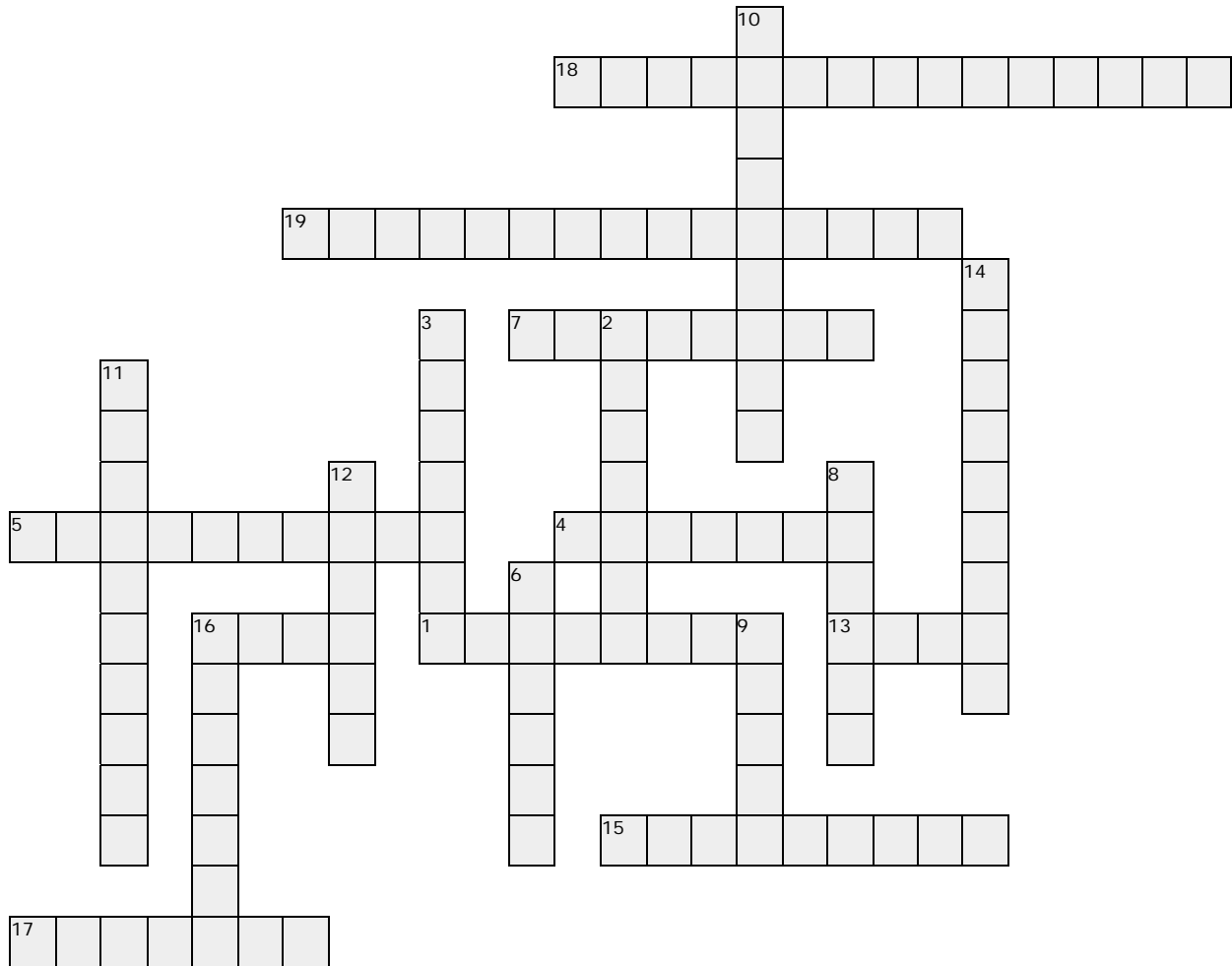
